05/01/2025 - 05/31/2025

The River Edge Police Department responded to or initiated 1,211 calls for service between May 1, 2025, and May 31, 2025:

Below are some examples of calls for service we responded to during this time period. All suspects are innocent unless or until proven guilty in a court of law.

• 05/03/2025 - 12:36 AM (Public Intoxication)

Officers responded to the area of Jordan Drive and Kinderkamack Road for a report of an intoxicated individual in the bushes along the roadway. A 35-year-old male from Palisades Park, New Jersey, was located and determined to be intoxicated. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment.

Officers responded to 7-Eleven at 584 Kinderkamack Road for a reported disturbance inside the store. A male was found yelling on his phone and refusing to leave. He was advised to exit the store and was issued a trespassing warning by the store manager not to return.

Brooks was also wanted by the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office. He was transported and turned over to Bergen County Jail.
